The Teatro Solís - Susana Salgado 2003-07-22

The first comprehensive history of the oldest major opera house in the Americas. The Teatro Solís in Montevideo, Uruguay—established in 1856 and still operating—is the oldest theater in the Americas. Programs also featured orchestra and dance: the theater played host to dancer Vaslav Nijinsky's last stage

performance and presented Puccini, Mascagni, Saint-Saëns and Richard Strauss. Susana Salgado's lively historical account—the very first of its kind—is enriched by anecdotes, reviews and illustrations.
